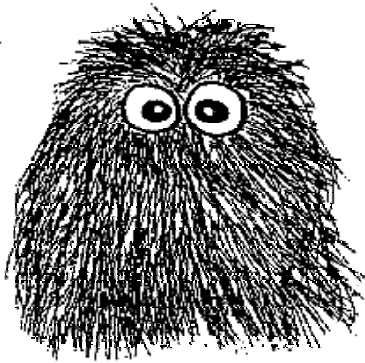


# Mimi/Mini Finger Puppets



Make your own puppets using the pattern provided. Play hide-and-seek with her just like she does in her song on "Quiche 2", "Tacos 1" and "Cheeseburgers"!

Stop the song cassette after each chorus and ask students to check under chairs, over cupboards, between books and in the wastebasket. (Hide Mimi or Mini before class.) Sometimes they find her, sometimes they don't! Think up new hiding places for her to hide in to teach new vocabulary.

A clothing unit: "Is she hiding in the hat? Under the shoe?"

An animal unit: "Between 2 monkeys? On top of the elephant?"

## Directions

**Materials:** I use pink "fur". Any color would be appropriate

**Pattern:** Trace this pattern onto an index card and cut the card out to use as a pattern.

Cut out two pieces of fake fur for each Mimi/Mini.

Place right sides of material together and sew, brushing the fur to the center so as not to catch it in your 1/2" seam.

Trim seam and turn right sides out.

Glue on wiggle eyes with a glue gun. Push fur out of the way and dot glue onto the fabric underneath so eyes will hold securely.

Some students will beg to keep her -- You might make extras!
